VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS “ANSWERED THE CALL” AND WILL DEPLOY TO NORTH CAROLINA = **UPDATE AS OF 1500 HRS. TODAY**

This news release is an update with regards to the deployment of our volunteer fire suppression assets to Raleigh North Carolina.

We have received notification through the Maryland Emergency Management Agency from Emergency Management Assistance Compact advising “the area that you would have worked in received a smaller than anticipated impact from the disaster caused by Hurricane Florence. At this time the deployment to Raleigh North Carolina has been suspended”.

Chief Kaufmann has asked all our assets to remain in a “standby” mode for the possibility for another assignment from the authorities in North Carolina and/or elsewhere.

We want to sincerely thank the men from Waldorf Volunteer Fire Department, Benedict Volunteer Fire Department, and their leaderships for the wonderful commitment of support to those experiencing difficulties in the southern region.
